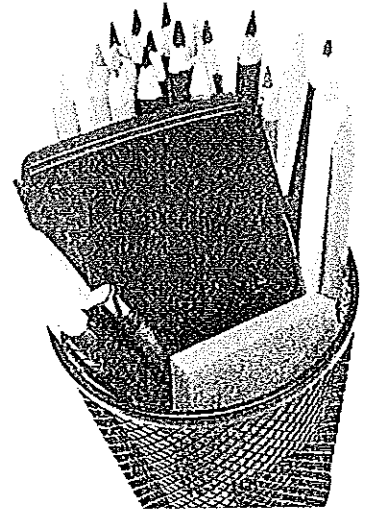

You will need:

 - Journal special events or free write at least two times a week

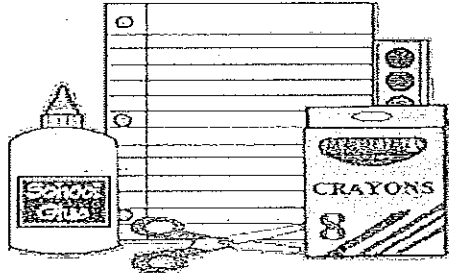
