

Before the Bell

Hours: 7:00 A.M. until the first bell at 8:20 a.m.

Cost: \$2.00 per child per day
(Fee qualifies for State assistance program)

Information is available about this program in the school office and at orientation.

****Students arriving at school before 8:05 a.m. MUST be enrolled in this program, as we do not have any other adult supervision and children will not be allowed inside the building until 8:05 a.m. when the first bell rings.**

School Hours

Student **MUST** enter in the door that is assigned to their grade level.

No one will be allowed to walk through the building from the front door.

ALL teachers will pick up students from morning assembly at 8:30 a.m. when school begins.

Arrival

Grades K

Students in Kindergarten should go to the outside door outside their child's classroom and be dropped off as close to 8:20 as possible. (Metiva, Room 101 door faces the side driveway. Dobrowolsky, Room 102, door faces the church and field)

Students in Grades K-2 should arrive by 8:20 a.m. and wait by the assigned doors for their grade level. (Safety patrol will be assigned to monitor these doors.)

Grades 1-2

Students in Grades 1 and 2 should be dropped off as close to 8:20 as possible and wait by their assigned doors . At 8:20 a.m. the students will be escorted to the gym for morning assembly.

GRADE 3

Students in Grade 3 will wait at the covered area at the doors by the cafeteria.

Students eating breakfast will be let into the cafeteria starting at 8:05 a.m. Students not eating breakfast should arrive to school at 8:20 a.m. and go to the gym for morning assembly.

Grades 4-6

Students in Grades 4-6 who want breakfast, will wait at the doors of the cafeteria by the playground, (in the back). All other 4-6 graders who do not eat breakfast should wait to come to school until 8:20 a.m. and go to the gym for morning assembly.

Dismissal

The dismissal bell rings at 3:20 P.M.

(Please note the area your child is to be picked up at on the following pages and adhere to that area to avoid confusion and traffic congestion.)

Student Door Assignments

Front driveway and parking lot:

The front horseshoe drive will open for Kindergarten parents and bus students ONLY. Please do not leave your car unless you are in a parking spot.

If you are picking up another student early for an appointment, you MUST park in the front parking lot and come into the office to check your child out from the office. You will be asked to wait in the office while we get your child. This will keep interruptions down to a minimum.

We are teaching up to 3:20 p.m.

Kindergarten

Morning Drop Off- Students should go to the outside door to their classroom and wait for the second bell at 8:30 a.m.

Mrs. Dpbrolowsky's door is facing the church.

Mrs. Metiva's door is facing the side driveway next to PREK.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed from the front horseshoe drive.

Only parents of Kindergarten children and buses will be allowed in the front drive at this time.

First Grade

Morning Drop Off- If not eating breakfast, students should be dropped off as close to 8:20a.m. as possible at the front door closest to the church and wait under the covered area in an orderly line.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed from the side driveway closest to Blackmore Street.

Second Grade

Morning Drop Off- Students should be dropped off as close to 8:20 a.m. as possible at the front door closest to the office and wait under the covered area in an orderly line.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed from the side driveway outside their classroom doors closest to Blackmore Street.

Third Grade

Morning Drop Off- If not eating breakfast, students should be dropped off as close to 8:20 a.m. as possible at the side doors closest to the cafeteria and wait there under the covered area in an orderly line.

If eating breakfast, students should be at the same doors by 8:05 a.m. to be let into the cafeteria.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed from the same area as morning drop off by the cafeteria doors.

Fourth Grade

Morning Drop Off- If not eating breakfast, students should be dropped off as close to 8:20a.m. as possible at the back door closest to the soccer field and wait there in an orderly line.

If eating breakfast, students should be dropped off at the same doors by 8:05 a.m. instead of 8:20 a.m.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed out the same door as the morning. Parents should pick students up on Martz Place.

Fifth Grade

Morning Drop Off- If not eating breakfast, students should be dropped off as close to 8:20 a.m. as possible at the back door by the playground that leads to the cafeteria and stand in an orderly fashion.

If eating breakfast, students should be dropped by 8:05 a.m. at the same doors instead of 8:20 a.m.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed out the back door by the playground. Parents should pick students up on Martz Place.

Sixth Grade

Morning Drop Off- If not eating breakfast, students should be dropped off as close to 8:25 a.m. as possible at the back door by the playground closest to the cafeteria.

If eating breakfast they should be dropped off at the same doors by 8:05 a.m.

Afternoon Pick Up- Students will be dismissed out the back door by the playground. Parents should pick students up on Martz Place.

****Reminder that we do not have supervision for children before first bell at 8:20 a.m. except students that are enrolled in Before the Bell. Students will not be allowed to play on the playground equipment or play basketball prior to school because there is not supervision at that time.**

PLEASE NOTE: Our traffic is tricky and tries everyone's patience. We do have to keep our children in mind as we speak to one another and during those times we all get impatient.

Sometimes it is best to wait 5 minutes to pick up when the traffic has been able to thin out.

The bus will pick up in the front this year to help with blockage in the side driveway but this means that the **front drive must be clear and no parking can be allowed in the horseshoe drive.**

This plan is designed to diminish problems between different grade levels and help with traffic issues. Your cooperation and that of your children is appreciated. Children should wait with their grade level.

PRE-Kindergarten Children- All Pre-Kindergarten children must be dropped off to Room 103 and picked up at that door by the side driveway. This is a federal regulation involving licensing to ensure the safety of these young children.

The PreK teacher will share with you the needs of the program including your volunteering in the class. It is acceptable and helpful for children to have a change of clothes at school. Please dress children for the weather. Also, be sure that your child is dressed to be comfortable and enjoy the school day. A.M. and P.M PreK students eat meals in their classroom.

After the Bell

After the Bell is available for children beginning at dismissal (3:20 P.M.). Children should report to the gym promptly after dismissal from class. If you cannot pick your child up after school at 3:20 then please plan to use After the Bell. Children must be registered and pre-paid. Information is available in the school office. The program provides supervision and a snack for children until 6:30. It is also available when there is only a half-day of school for students. Please see Mrs. May or the school office for more information.
