PLEASE NOTE: Half-day high school SASA students are advised to check with officials at other schools to verify class meeting times that are required at their Home schools. SASA’s afternoon schedule will remain the same for full and half day students (9th, 10th, & 11th grades).

High School lockers should be cleaned out by noon on June 13.

Buses: On June 12th & 13th, there are no afternoon exams for the high school unless there is a scheduled make up. The middle school day will not be affected by the high school exam schedule. The after school bus schedule will not change for Midland and Bay City students. Students who need to wait for the Bay City or Midland Bus must be in a supervised area, such as in a classroom with a teacher or they may work in the Media Center until the end of the middle school day. Parents may pick their student(s) up after exams.
