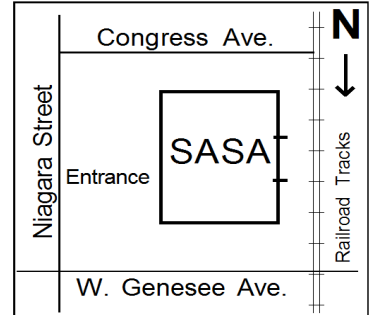
All sections of this application must be completed before any consideration can be given.
