



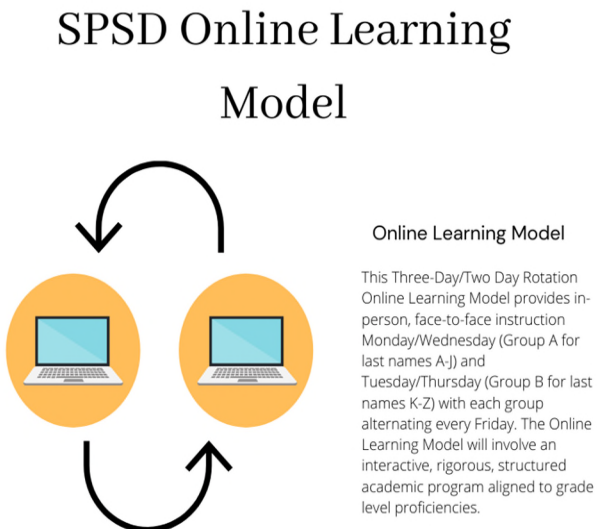
## Saginaw Public Schools' *Online Learning Model*

We look forward to welcoming our students back for the 2020-21 school year!

The Saginaw City School District has plans in place to safely and responsibly deliver high-quality education to students during the upcoming academic year. While we have created the plans that best suit our community, things change rapidly. As events in our city, county, region and state change, so may our plans. We will communicate this information to you as soon as possible through our website and social media sites. On Wednesday, August 19, 2020, the Saginaw Board of Education approved an updated start plan. Our plan consists of one Online Computer-to-Computer Learning Model that will provide 100% remote instruction in a digital format. *Student Orientations are scheduled the week of August 31-September 4, 2020.*

### ONLINE COMPUTER-TO-COMPUTER SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING MODEL

In switching to this format, community, staff and student perspectives were kept at the forefront. Parent and community survey data highlighted the importance of *student relationships* with staff and students, access to technology, high quality curriculum, instruction, and academic support. SPSD's online learning environment is designed to best serve the educational needs of our students, and includes:



#### Online Learning Model:

- Teacher-Student direct instruction

- Student Supports on opposite face-to-face instructional days

#### Saginaw Public Schools Expectations for Students:

- Class participation, attendance of live lessons, continuation of learning and completion of all assignments. Teachers will record attendance for all live lessons.
- Students expected to attend orientation the week of August 31 through September 4 to pick up class schedule, meet teachers, sign-out Chromebook, receive login, zoom, google classroom access and teacher contact information. **Schools will post times for orientation on the website and social media on Monday, August 24, 2020.**
- Students are expected to be ON TIME for every live lesson (Attendance will be taken), and complete all work on opposite days
- Students are expected to adhere to the SPSD code-of-conduct during every class and activity.
- Students expected to complete all district assessments and communicate with teachers as needed.
- The SPSD Online Learning Model will be evaluated every 4 weeks.
