Re: Rise in Cases/Suspension of Face to Face Instruction Pre-K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

Dear Colleagues:

After reviewing the data from the Saginaw County Health Department on Covid-19 cases this past Friday, Saginaw County is now above a 7.2% positivity rate which is a 3% increase from the previous week. Therefore, I have made the decision not to allow Pre-K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade students to return to school for in person learning on Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> will be a regular Zoom session for all students. In addition, I will be making a recommendation to the Board at a Special Meeting on Monday, Nov 2<sup>nd</sup>, for all students to remain in the online model until the end of the first semester.
