




Saginaw Public Schools Return to School *Learning Models*

ONLINE LEARNING MODEL

To start the school year, all **PreK-12** students will attend school virtually on SPSP's online face-to-face learning platform using zoom Monday-Friday. This updated online learning model consists of Online Computer-to-Computer Learning Model that will provide 100% face-to-face instruction via zoom **five (5) days per week beginning February 2, 2021 and ending February 26, 2021**. In switching to this format, community, staff and student perspectives were kept at the forefront. Parent and community survey data highlighted the importance of *student relationships* with staff and students, access high quality curriculum, instruction, and academic support 5 days per week.

SPSD Online Learning Model



Online Learning Model:

- Teacher-Student direct instruction 5 days per week (Monday-Friday)
- Student-Student connection and engagement
- Social-Emotional Support
- Digital Learning Environment (Zoom & Google classroom)
- Access to high quality, rigorous, coherent curriculum in a digital format
- Letter Grades and issuance of credits
- Chromebooks provided for every student
- Wi-Fi hotspots and Digital Learning Labs as needed
- Breakfast and Lunch provided by SodexoMagic

FACE-TO-FACE [ALL IN] LEARNING MODEL WITH SAFETY PROTOCOLS

On March 1, all **PreK-12** students will return to school for face-to-face in person instruction. Students will follow their entire schedule and attend face-to-face instruction on an A/B rotation. Students will receive face-to-face instruction Monday/Wednesday (Group A) and Tuesday/Thursday (Group B). All students will remain home on Fridays and receive instruction via zoom.

Realizing that some parents may not want to have their child return to school for face-to-face because of the risks posed by the COVID-19 virus, our Extended Learning Plan includes a full-time at-home Virtual Academy to meet their needs. The SPSP Virtual Academy will offer Seesaw (PreK), Lincoln Learning (K-6) and Edmentum (7-12). While this is a self-guided platform with 100% remote instruction, courses will be monitored by SPSP teachers to assure progress and completion. Attendance, student engagement with their prescribed curriculum, and academic progress will be assessed, and students will receive letter grades.

SPSD Hybrid Model



This A/B Hybrid Learning Model provides in-person, face-to-face instruction in school Monday/Wednesday (Group A) and Tuesday/Thursday (Group B) with all students participating in virtual, face-to-face instruction via zoom every Friday.

All students will stay home on Fridays and receive instruction via zoom.
