Dear SPSD Students and Parents:

Below you will find important updated changes to the Saginaw Public Schools (SPSD) COVID-19 Protocols and Procedures/Guidelines to follow when exposed to or testing positive for COVID-19. **The information provided are based on the new recommendations from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Saginaw County Health Department (SCHD).**

All staff and students are required to abide by the Saginaw Public Schools COVID-19 guidelines and procedures. Students who also attend school districts outside of Saginaw Public Schools, must adhere to the SPSD guidelines.

SPSD Students & Staff COVID-19 Protocols

- Masks are optional for all staff and students
- Daily Disinfection Classroom Fogging
- Desks will be 3 Feet Apart
- Sanitizing Stations Located in Several Places Through Out Each Building
- Touchless Water Fountains Located Throughout Each Building
- Air Purifiers Located Throughout Each Building
- Students/Staff will be Monitored for Fevers as They Enter Building
- Students Testing Positive Required to Quarantine for 5 Days from Date of Test
- Students/Staff are to stay home if they do not feel well
- CDC and SCHD Recommendations will be Followed

EXPOSURE & TESTING POSITIVE for COVID-19

Please note:

- *Based on information provided by the Saginaw County Health Department, only known positive cases that occurred within 48 hours of a staff or student being in a building are required to be reported to staff, parents, the health department, and on the district’s website.*

Isolation and Quarantine Guidance

No Quarantine

If you have been boosted, completed the primary series Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 5 months, or J & J vaccine within the last 2 months, or have had COVID-19 within the last 90 days:

Exposed to Covid-19	Tested Positive for COVID-19: Isolation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can report to work or school, but must wear a mask around others for 10 days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you test positive of COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, stay home for 5 days.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test on day 5, if possible to make sure you do not have COVID-19. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house/report to work or school.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff must notify their immediate supervisor and HR when testing positive for COVID-19 (You must do both). • Students and Parents must notify the building principal of positive test results immediately. SPSD Buildings principals must notify the district’s nurses and follow all positive case reporting guidelines.

Yes Quarantine

If you have completed the primary series Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 5 months ago or J & J over two months ago and are NOT boosted, or are unvaccinated:

Exposed to Covid-19	Tested Positive for COVID-19: Isolation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you test positive of COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, stay home for 5 days.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you can't quarantine, you must wear a mask for 10 days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house/report to work or school.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Test on day 5, if possible to make sure you do not have COVID-19. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff must notify their immediate supervisor and HR when testing positive for COVID-19 (You must do both). Students and Parents must notify the building principal of positive test results immediately. SPSD Buildings principals must notify the district's nurses and follow all positive case reporting guidelines.

As a reminder, all staff and students will continue to practice social distancing by remaining 3 to 6 feet apart and wearing a face mask. In addition, **staff and students experiencing one or more of the following symptoms should not report to work or school** unless you have medical clearance stating that the symptoms below are not COVID- 19 related and you are no longer contagious.

- Fever
- Cough
- Difficult breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle aches
- Diarrhea
- Sore throat
- Nausea
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Any newly developed respiratory symptoms
